This notice is provided to you in accordance with Saratoga County Local Law 1 of 2012.

The intent of this law is to ensure citizens receive accurate information about their County property tax bill and the County budget annually.

UNFUNDED MANDATES

Unfunded mandates are New York State and federal laws, regulations, or rules that impose obligations on county government without including the funding or resources required for compliance. Unfunded mandates shift the financial burden to the local taxpayer and county government has little to no control over these costs.

IMPACT ON COUNTY BUDGET & TAX BILL

The 2026 County Budget totals \$434 million, with \$86,541,951 dedicated to programs mandated by New York State. This amount exceeds the county's entire share of the property tax levy, meaning 100% of county property taxes will go toward covering these unfunded state mandates. To cover the full cost, the county will need to use an additional \$8,741,951 from sales tax revenue.



TAX BILL BREAKDOWN

On an average annual residential tax bill, your taxes are divided as follows: 14% local, 13% county, and 73% schools.

The property tax rate will be reduced again in 2026. This reduction maintains Saratoga County's standing as having the lowest property tax rate of all upstate counties.
