 Any proposed construction, grading, filling, excavating, clearing or other regulated activity in the freshwater wetland or within 100 feet of the wetland boundary as depicted on this plan requires a permit from the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation under Article 24 of the Environmental Conservation Law (Freshwater Wetlands Act) prior to commencement of work.



I have reviewed the wetland delineation map entitled "65 Reynolds Road Wetland Delineation Map", dated September 23, 2024. The wetland boundary on this map accurately depicts the limits of Freshwater Wetland F-7 as verified by the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC).

The wetland boundary validated by the DEC remains valid for five years from the validation (October 29, 2024). For official use of the wetland boundary after this five-year period, the boundary must be re-validated by DEC staff. This may include additional flagging and survey of the wetland boundary if changes are noted.

Be advised that changes to Article 24 regulations are expected in January of 2025; therefore, jurisdictional determinations depicted on the map referenced above are only valid until December 31, 2024. Information regarding wetland mapping and jurisdictional determinations may be subject to change when new regulations go into effect.
