Dear Resident/Landowner:

As you are aware, the Town has been evaluating the potential of creating a sewer district in the commercial corridor of Route 9 to promote economic development in the area. The topic has been discussed, at length, over the past few months at several Town Board meetings. The meetings provided for informal input from interested members of the community. Based upon those meetings and deliberation by the Board, the Town has decided to move forward with the formal process of sewer district formation. The first step of the process is to hold the official public hearing concerning creation of the sewer district. Enclosed is a copy of the published official notice of the public hearing for your use. While not required to do so, the Town Board wanted to take the additional step to notify you by mail of this important date. The hearing will take place on Wednesday, May 16<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall.

The purpose of the hearing is to afford you the opportunity to let the Town Board know your thoughts concerning the proposed sewer project. I encourage you to attend and to speak at the hearing so the Town Board is made aware of your opinion and comments related to the project, prior to making a decision to move forward.
