

Moreau is a "No Sort" recycling facility.

We recycle all these items in one bin:

- Loose paper
- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Soft-covered books
- Shredded paper in clear bags
- Flattened cardboard boxes
- Cans and bottles that are emptied and rinsed
- All plastic with the Recycle triangle
- Empty pizza boxes

Please see the booth attendant to pay and receive directions for <u>Styrofoam</u> and <u>Hard-covered books</u>.

PLEASE NOTE:

<u>Only</u> bagged household trash goes in the compactor.

Please ask the attendant for a list of disposal fees for residents and non-residents. Disposal fees are based on the type of item and/or the size of the trash bag.

Please do **NOT** put <u>animal waste</u> or kitty <u>litter</u> in the compactor. It can be paid for and placed in the open bin.

 We can only accept payment in cash or check form.
- Please ask the attendant for your receipt if you do not receive one.
- Vehicle stickers are available for residents from the **booth attendant** at no charge.

Helpful hints for disposal of miscellaneous waste items

<u>Gasoline</u>, 2-cycle fuels, pesticides, and household hazardous waste can be added to cat litter or sawdust and allowed to evaporate for a few days. Once it has evaporated, we will accept it.

<u>Paint Cans</u> - We do NOT accept paint that is still in liquid form. To dry it, you can either:

- Open the cans and allow it to dry
- Add cat litter to absorb it
- Line a cardboard box with newspaper and pour the paint in until it dries

<u>Tires</u> - We accept up to two (2) tires per day per customer.

We do NOT accept:

- <u>Construction debris</u>, cement blocks, shingles, insulation etc. Please call Hiram Hollow at (518) 793-1098 to dispose of them.
- <u>Electronics</u>. Please call the Queensbury Transfer Station at (518) 745-4479 to dispose of them.
- Needles and syringes. Glens Falls Hospital accepts these for disposal.



The following items are available at no cost to Moreau residents for their <u>personal</u> use.

Please speak to attendants if you are unsure where to dump these items.

<u>Disposal of tree branches</u> that are from cleaning your yard are accepted up to 4' in length and 4" in diameter. We do **not** accept wood and branches from lot clearing.

Disposal of leaves and lawn clippings.

<u>Disposal of large appliances</u> can be placed in the open top container. <u>If they contain Freon,</u> please do NOT place them in the bin. Put them in the space provided, and Saratoga County will remove the Freon before recycling.

<u>Disposal of most metal items</u>, car batteries, and empty propane tanks.

<u>Free</u> wood chips based on availability for Moreau and SGF residents' personal use. Due to safety concerns, our staff can NOT help load them.
