

UPDATE: COVID-19 Information for Saratoga County

Low-risk exposure in Saratoga Springs

The Saratoga County Public Health Department and its team of contact tracers have determined that there was a low-risk exposure last week in Saratoga Springs at the Bourbon Room, located at 8 Caroline Street. An employee tested positive for COVID-19, and worked on Thursday, July 16, Friday July 17 and Saturday July 18 from 5:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.

While the employee who tested positive was wearing a mask at all times, anyone who visited the bar on those dates should self-monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and contact their health care provider to get a diagnostic test.
