UPDATE: COVID-19 Information for Saratoga County April 30, 2020

Ballston Spa, NY — The Saratoga County Department of Public Health Services today announced that there are 349 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Saratoga County and 10 of those individuals are hospitalized at this time.

The Department confirmed the death of two more county residents from COVID-19 — a 78-year-old female from Hadley and a 66-year-old male from Halfmoon. The total number of resident deaths from COVID-19 now stands at 14.
