What businesses should consider prior to reopening

The Capital Region has started the reopening process. This will take place in phases, and not all businesses will be allowed to reopen immediately. A breakdown of the businesses that are included in each phase can be found here.

Every business should be thinking about the following things:

- Physical spacing and incorporating distancing where possible
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Health screening process for employees
- Cleaning protocols and supplies
- Log of people in the building (employees and visitors)

Mask Information

As we begin to reopen, it is important to continue wearing a mask when out in public. There is a proper way to put on, wear and take off a face mask or covering.
