Ms. Trombley explained that after each law is passed, it's send to the NYS Department of State, and once the Town receives confirmation, she sends it to General Code for integration into the existing code. She said the cost of each update depends on how much existing code is impacted by the new law. She added that paper updates are made as well, and that the number of books in use had been slimmed down.
