Supervisor Jenkins called the meeting to order at 9:15 p.m.

The Town Clerk called the roll.

Tim Burley distributed a long form EAF to the Town Board and Town Clerk. Part 1 of the EAF was already completed and the Town Board has to go through Part 2 and 3 of the EAF.

Tim Burley distributed to the Town Board and Town Clerk copies of letters he received from involved agencies regarding the Town's request to be lead agency in the Extension 4 of Sewer District 1 project. He went through the letters from involved agencies and recapped what their answers were.

The following is a recap of responses from the involved agencies:

NYS DEC, Division of Environmental Permits, replied that they agreed with the Town Board being lead agency in the Extension 4 Sewer 1 project.

The Capital District Regional Planning Commission agreed with the Town Board being lead agency in the Extension 4 Sewer 1 project.

The New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation didn't respond to the affirmative or negative. Their letter read in part that their determination will be made after all documentation of requirements noted on any enclosures has been met. They included archaeological comments.

NYS DEC, Division of Fish, Wildlife & Marine Resources/New York Natural Heritage Program, did not respond to the affirmative or negative. Their letter read that if the project is still under development one year from now, they recommend that the Town contact them again for updated information on rare or state-listed animals and plants. They included a list of rare or state-listed animals and plants with their letter. They could not provide a statement as to the presence of any of these rare or state-listed animals and plants being present in the project area.

The Saratoga County Department of Public Works did not reply to the affirmative or negative. Their letter simply read that they plan to reconstruct County Road 27, Bluebird Road in 2015. They also plan to reconstruct County Route 28, but the time frame has not been established.

Tim Burley read the questions in Part 2 of the EAF and questions 1 through 18 were answered in the negative (No).

It was determined in Part 3 of that this is a Type 1 Action under SEQRA and that the project will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts.

A motion was made by Councilman Vittengl and seconded by Councilwoman LeClair declaring a negative declaration under SEQRA and that there is no significant adverse environmental impacts and authorizing the Supervisor to sign the EAF.

WHEREAS, all the property and property owners benefited are included within the limits of the proposed Extension No. 4; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to establish the proposed Extension No. 4; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board as lead agency has issued a determination of non-significance under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") for this Type I action;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the establishment of the proposed Extension No. 4 is hereby approved, as hereinafter described, and said Extension No. 4 shall be designated and known as Sewer District No. 1, Extension No. 4 in the Town of Moreau, and shall consist of 1231 acres, include 286 parcels as is more fully detailed and described in the Map, Plan and Report, and as identified by tax map parcel number in Schedule A attached hereto; and

BE IT FURTHERRESOLVED, that the maximum amount proposed to be expended for the construction of Extension No. 4 is estimated to be \$14,115,000.00 and the plan of financing includes the issuance of \$14,115,000 serial bonds from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund ("CWSRF") and the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation ("EFC") maturing in annual installments over a

period not exceeding thirty (30) years; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town of Moreau may, if deemed necessary, enter into an Addendum to the Facility Agreement with the Board of Water and Sewer Commissioners of the City of Glens Falls to provide for additional reserve capacity at the Glens Falls Sewage Treatment Plant particular to the waste water generated from the Extension No. 4 parcels, and the Supervisor is authorized to enter into any such addendum on behalf of the Town upon recommendation from the attorney for the Town; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Rules and Regulations for Sewer District No. 1 contained in Article 1 of Chapter 115 of the Moreau Town Code shall apply to and be enforced in Extension No. 4; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Supervisor and Town Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and delivery all necessary documents to further the purposes of this resolution, including the filing of this Resolution in the Office of the Saratoga County Clerk and the Office of the State Department of Audit and Control; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the permission of the State Comptroller is not required with respect to Extension No. 4 because the estimated cost of Extension No. 4 to the Typical Property (as defined in the Town Law) is not above the Average Estimated Cost to the Typical Properties for the establishment of similar types of districts, as computed by the State Comptroller, and the Clerk will file a certified copy of this Order with the State Comptroller as required by the Town Law; and

BE IT FURTHERRESOLVED, that this resolution is subject to a permissive referendum in the manner provided by law.

Supervisor Jenkins replied that there isn't enough time to go to mandatory referendum.

Harry Gutheil replied that if they scheduled the vote tonight they may have time to and still meet the deadline.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a regular meeting held on the 26th day of December, 2013, the Town Board of the Town of Moreau, Saratoga County, New York, duly adopted the following resolution, which resolution is subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to Section 35 of the Local Finance Law and. Article 7 of the Town Law of the State of New York:

### SERIAL BOND RESOLUTION DATED DECEMBER 26, 2013

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$14,115,000 SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN OF MOREAU, SARATOGA COUNTY, NEW YORK FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER DISTRICT NO. 1 EXTENSION NO. 4 IN THE TOWN OF MOREAU, AND ALL NECESSARY INFRASTRUCTURE, APPURTENANCES, AND APPARATUS

WHEREAS, on December 26, 2013, the Town Board of the Town of Moreau adopted a resolution authorizing the construction of Sewer District No. 1, Extension No. 4 in the Town of Moreau, and all necessary infrastructure, appurtenances, and apparatus and to provide for the financing thereof, at a maximum cost of \$14,115,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary to be paid from the proceeds of the obligations issued pursuant to the Local Finance Law; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost is now estimated to be \$14.115,000; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has applied for funding for the project through the New York Clean Water and State Revolving Fund ("CWSRF") and the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation ("EFC"); and

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill the requirements of the CWSRF application, the Town is required to pass a bond resolution authorizing the issuance of serial bonds to finance the project through CWSRF and EFC; and

WHEREAS, the maximum cost of the project is estimated to be \$14,115,000, with the sum of \$14,115,000 to be paid from the proceeds of obligations issued pursuant to the Local Finance Law; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to authorize such payment and to provide for the financing thereof through the CWSRF and EFC; and

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Town Board of the Town of Moreau, Saratoga County, New York, hereby authorizes the construction of Sewer District No. 1, Extension No. 4 in the Town of Moreau and all necessary infrastructure, appurtenances and apparatus located in the Town of Moreau at a maximum cost of \$14,115,000.
- 2. The specific object or purpose for which obligations are to be issued pursuant to this resolution is the construction of Sewer District No. 1, Extension No. 4 in the Town of Moreau and all necessary infrastructure, appurtenances, and apparatus located in the Town of Moreau. New York.

- 3. The current maximum cost of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is \$14,115,000, and shall be financed up to a \$14,115,000 30 year zero percent or low interest loan, CWSRF loan, including the necessary construction loan financing and the balance thereof, if any, shall be paid through other available sources of funding. The issuance of serial bonds of the Town of Moreau in the amount of \$14,115,000 is hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Finance Law. Such serial bonds are to be payable from amounts which shall be paid from the users of Sewer District No. 1 in the Town of Moreau and/or ad valorem rates and/or amounts which shall be annually levied on all of the taxable real property in said Town and the faith and credit of the Town of Moreau, Saratoga County, New York, are hereby pledged for the payment of said bonds and the interest thereon.
- 4. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is forty (40) years, pursuant to subdivision 1 of Paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.
- 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Town Supervisor of the Town of Moreau, the chief fiscal officer, or in his absence, the Deputy Town Supervisor, who is the substituted chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be determined by said Town Supervisor or Deputy Town Supervisor pursuant to and consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.
- 6. This resolution is adopted subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to Section 35 of the Local Finance Law and Article 7 of the Town Law of the State of New York.
- 7. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:
  - a. Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said Town Board is not authorized to spend money; or
  - b. The provisions of law which should be complied with as of the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of such publication; or
  - c. Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.
- 8. This notice and resolution shall be published in full within ten (10) days after its adoption in the Post Star, which is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Town for such purpose. This resolution shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption and thereafter shall be published in full in the Post Star, together with a notice of the Town Clerk substantially in the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.
